

Community Show Year End High Point Program - 2010

1. The categories will be as follows:
  - a. A champion and reserve champion will be named in each class on the show bill with the exception of championship classes.
  - b. A circuit champion and reserve champion will be awarded in the following divisions: Walk/Trot 10 & Under, Rookie, 13 & Under, 14-17, 18 & Over.
2. Points will be awarded as follows:
  - a. One point for yourself and one point for every horse you beat. For example, if there are eight horses in a class first place would receive eight points, second place would receive seven points, etc.
  - b. Only horses placing sixth or better will receive points. Points will not be given for seventh, eighth, or honorable mention.
3. Lead line riders are not required to have a WMAHA membership to be eligible for the year end award. All riders showing in a lead line class will receive a year end participation award. Riders in the Walk Only class must have a WMAHA membership to be eligible for awards.
4. There will be one champion and one reserve champion named. In the event that a tie breaker is required the following method will be used: the number of 1<sup>st</sup> places in the division that the tie has occurred will be compared and the horse with highest number of 1<sup>st</sup> places will win. If this cannot break the tie (either because both horses have an equal number of 1<sup>st</sup> places or neither horse has a first place) then we will compare the number of 2<sup>nd</sup> places etc. until the tie can be broken.
5. In order to be eligible for the program you must be a WMAHA member by April 1. The list of members will be posted on the website ([www.wmaha.org](http://www.wmaha.org)) for review. Any horse shown by a WMAHA member will automatically be included in the program. If you are not on the list and you believe that is a mistake OR you become a member after April 1 it is **your responsibility** to send a copy of your AHA membership card to the awards committee.
