

Class A Year End High Point Program - 2010

1. The categories will be as follows:
 - a. Adult (one horse/one rider)
 - b. Youth (one horse/one rider, equitation/showmanship will count, walk/trot included)
 - c. Halter (one horse/any handlers, all halter classes and sport horse in hand)
 - d. Hunter Pleasure (one horse/any riders, all hunter pleasure and sport horse under saddle, walk/trot pleasure classes will count)
 - e. Western Pleasure (one horse/any riders, all western pleasure classes count including walk/trot pleasure classes)
 - f. Country/English Pleasure (one horse/any riders, all country pleasure and english pleasure classes count including walk/trot, park does not count)
 - g. Specialty (one horse/any riders, all native costume, dressage, reining, show hack, park, sidesaddle, and driving classes will count)

2. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - a. Class A Shows All Classes (including Championship)
 - i. 1 – 3 entries: 1st = 3 points, 2nd = 2 points, 3rd = 1 point
 - ii. 4 – 6 entries: 1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, 6th = 1 point
 - iii. Over 6 entries: 1 point for yourself and one point for every horse you beat (ex. 10 horses in a class 1st = 10 points, 2nd = 9 points, etc.)
 - b. Region 13 Championship Show
 - i. Regional Champion (regardless of number in class) = 15 points
 - ii. Regional Reserve Champion (regardless of number in class) = 12 points
 - iii. Regional Top 5 (regardless of number in class) = 8 points

3. The following shows will count (pending addition/subtraction of shows for 2010):
 - a. AHAM All – Arabian
 - b. MHSA
 - c. HAAM Showtime
 - d. Region 13 Championships
 - e. MSU Summer Show
 - f. AHAM Summer Show
 - g. WMAHA Fall Classic

4. In each of the 7 divisions awards will be given as follows: CHAMPION, RESERVE, 3 TOP FIVES.

5. There will be one champion, one reserve champion, and three top fives named in each division. In the event that a tie breaker is required the following method will be used: the number of 1st places in the division that the tie has occurred will be compared and the horse with highest number of 1st places will win. If this cannot break the tie (either because both horses have an equal number of 1st places or neither horse has a first place) then we will compare the number of 2nd places etc. until the tie can be broken.

6. In order to be eligible for the program you must be a WMAHA member by April 1. The list of members will be posted on the website (www.wmaha.org) for review. Any horse shown by a WMAHA member will automatically be included in the program. If you are not on the list and you believe that is a mistake OR you become a member after April 1 it is **your responsibility** to send a copy of your membership card to the awards committee. Points will accumulate from the time that proof of membership is verified. Copies of cards should be mailed to:
